ASSIGNMENT: This purchase order shall not be transferred or assigned to any other Vendor, contractor, bank, lending institution or to any representative or individual without the District's consent which consent may be withheld for any reason.

MODIFICATIONS: No modification of this purchase order shall be binding unless the modification is approved in writing by representatives of both parties authorized to modify the purchase order.

EXCUSABLE DELAYS: The District may at its option, grant additional time for any delay or failure to perform under this purchase order if the delay will not adversely impact the best interest of the District and is due to causes beyond the control of the Vendor. Such grant must be in writing and made part of the order.

<u>DEFAULT</u>: In the event of default by the Vendor, the District may procure the articles or services covered by this order from other sources and hold the Vendor responsible for any excess cost occasioned by such procurement. The following shall be considered a default:

(1) Failure to make complete deliveries within the promised time, (2) Unauthorized substitution or delivery of goods deemed by the District to be inferior. (3) Inability of the Vendor to fulfill the terms and conditions of this order.

TERMINATION FOR DEFAULT: The District reserves the right to terminate this order in whole or in part for default if (a) the Vendor fails to perform in accordance with any of the requirements of this order, or if (b) the Vendor becomes insolvent or suspends any of its operations or if any petition is filed or proceeding commenced by or against the Vendor under any State or Federal law relating to bankruptcy arrangement, reorganization, receivership, or assignment for the benefit of creditors. Any such termination will be without liability to the District except for completed items delivered and accepted by the District. The Vendor will be liable for excess costs of re-procurement.

TERMINATION FOR CONVENIENCE/WITHOUT CAUSE: The District reserves the right to terminate this purchase order in whole or in part, at any time and for any reason. If the purchase order should be terminated for convenience, the District will be relieved of all obligations under this order. The District will only be required to pay to the Vendor that amount of the order actually performed to the date of termination or goods received to the date of termination.

SHIPPING TERMS: Unless otherwise specified, all shipments shall be F.O.B. Destination, Freight Pre-paid. Orders must be delivered to the "ship to" address as stated on this purchase order. Any deviations (without prior approval from the District) will constitute a refusal of shipment. Such refusal, requiring redistribution, reshipment and/or storage charges, will be borne by the Vendor. The District will not be responsible for any lost shipment caused by improper shipment.

<u>PAYMENT TERMS</u>: By accepting this order, the Vendor agrees that payment terms shall be as set forth in accordance with the Florida Prompt Payment Act.

INVOICING: Except as otherwise stated in this purchase order, the Vendor must render the original invoice to the District at the address stated on the order. The purchase order number must appear on all invoices, packing slips, shipping notices, freight bills, and correspondence concerning this order.

TAXES: The District is exempt from Federal and State Taxes, both excise and sales and use, and any other like taxes. Vendors doing business with the District shall not be exempt from paying sales tax to their suppliers for materials to fulfill contractual obligations with District, nor shall any Vendor be authorized to use the District's tax exemption number in securing such materials.

CONTRACT TERMS: If this purchase order is a result of a competitive solicitation award, all conditions, provisions and specifications of the solicitation shall become a part of and are incorporated into this purchase order.

INTERPRETATION; VENUE. This purchase order shall be interpreted as a whole unit, and section headings are for convenience only. All interpretations shall be governed by the laws of the State of Florida. In the event it is necessary for either party to initiate legal action regarding this purchase order, venue shall be in the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit, in and for St. Lucie County, Florida, for claims under state law, and in the Southern District of Florida for claims justiciable in federal court. DELIVERIES: Deliveries are to be made to the indicated ship to address between the hours of 9:00 A.M. and 4:00 P.M. Monday through Friday, excluding holidays, unless otherwise stipulated. The Vendor shall notify the receiving site of deliveries that require special handling or assistance for off-loading. Failure to give notice will result in the Vendor being billed for any add-on, redelivery, storage, or handling charges.

INSPECTION: All materials or goods will be received "subject to inspection and acceptance." Materials or goods found defective or not in accordance with the District's instructions, specifications, drawings, or other data, will remain the property of the Vendor. The District will cancel the purchase order and the materials or goods will be returned at the Vendor's expense. The receipt of or payment for materials and goods shall not be deemed as an acceptance thereof.

QUANTITIES: Quantities specified in the order may not be changed without prior written approval of the District. Goods shipped in excess of the quantity designated may be returned at the Vendor's expense. A packing list must be included in each shipment. If no packing list accompanies the shipment, the District's count will be accepted.

<u>PAYMENT CHANGES</u>: Payments will be made only to the company and address as set forth on the purchase order unless the Vendor has requested a change on official company letterhead signed by an authorized officer of the company.

ANTI-DISCRIMINATION: Vendors doing business with the District are prohibited from discriminating against any employee, applicant, or client because of age, ancestry, citizenship status, color, disability, ethnicity, genetic information, gender, gender expression, gender identity, marital status, medical condition, national origin, political beliefs, pregnancy, race, religion, religious beliefs, sex, sexual orientation, or veteran status with regard to, but not limited to, the following: employment practices, rates of pay or other compensation methods, and training selection.

<u>LIABILITY - COPYRIGHT/PATENT/TRADEMARK</u>: The Vendor shall save and hold harmless the District, its employees and agents from liability for infringement of any United States patent trademark, or copyright for, or on account of, the use of any product sold to the District or used in the performance of this order.

INDEMNIFICATION: Vendor agrees to indemnify, save, and hold harmless the District, its

employees and agents, against any and all claims, damages, liability and court awards including costs, expenses, and attorney fees incurred as a result of any act or omission by the Vendor, or its employees, agents, subcontractors, or assignees arising out of the services provided under this Purchase Order.

INSURANCE: Seller agrees to maintain insurance in accordance with the insurance standards established by the District Manager.

WARRANTY: The Vendor warrants and represents to the District that each item of goods or products provided pursuant to this purchase order shall: (a) strictly conform to the requirements of this purchase order, (b) be free from defects in workmanship, materials and design, (c) be merchantable, (d) be fit for its intended use, and (e) be new. Unless otherwise stated in the purchase order, no surplus, rebuilt, reconditioned, or used goods shall be provided. The Vendor warrants that any services provided shall: (a) be performed in a good and competent manner in accordance with professional industry standards (with the level of skill, knowledge and judgment required or reasonably expected of providers of comparable services), (b) meet the terms of this purchase order, and (c) be free from defects. This warranty for quality of services shall be effective for two (2) years after acceptance of all work unless specified otherwise in a bid/proposal award.

MATERIAL SAFETY DATA SHEET: The Vendor agrees to furnish the District with a current Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS) on or before delivery of each and every hazardous chemical or substance purchased which is classified as toxic under Chapter 442, Florida Statutes. Appropriate labels and MSDS's shall be provided for all shipments. Send MSDS's and other pertinent data to the District at the address stated on this purchase order.

<u>PUBLICITY</u>: Use by the District of products or services shall, in no way, constitute an endorsement and the District's name will not be used by the Vendor in any way, manner, or form in product literature or advertising.

LEGAL COMPLIANCE: The Vendor guarantees that the services to be performed and the goods to be provided herein, shall comply with all applicable federal, state and local laws, ordinances, regulations, orders and decrees, including without limitation such of the following acts as may be applicable: Federal Consumer Product Safety Act, Federal Fair Labor Standards Act, Occupational Safety and Health Act, Buy American, Energy Policy and Conservation, Federal Hazardous Substances Labeling Act, Byrd Anti-lobbying, Federal Flammable Fabrics Act, Clean Air & Water Pollution Acts, Copeland Anti-Kickback, Davis Bacon Act and any applicable environmental regulations.

E-VERIFY: The Vendor shall: (a) Register with and use the E-Verify system to verify the work authorization status of all newly hired employees pursuant to Section 448.095(2), Florida Statutes, and require all subcontractors to do the same; (b) Secure an affidavit from all subcontractors stating that the subcontractor does not employ, contract with, or subcontract with an "unauthorized alien" as defined in Section 448.095(1)(f), Florida Statutes; (c) Maintain copies of all subcontractor affidavits for the duration of this Agreement and provide same to the District upon request, (c) Comply fully, and ensure all of its subcontractors comply fully, with Section 448.095, Florida Statutes; (d) Be aware that a violation of Section 448.095(1), Florida Statutes (Unauthorized aliens; employment prohibited) shall be grounds for termination of this Agreement; and ϵ Be aware that a violation of Section 448.095(5) by a subcontractor, and not the Vendor , shall be grounds for the District to order the Vendor immediately terminate the contract with the subcontractor; and (f) Be aware that if the District terminates this Agreement under Section 448.095(5)(c), Florida Statutes, the Vendor may not be awarded a contract for at least 1 year after the date on which the Agreement is terminated and will be liable for any additional costs incurred by the District as a result of the termination of the Agreement.

<u>PUBLIC RECORDS</u>. The Vendor shall allow public access to all documents, papers, letters, and other materials that are subject to the provisions of Chapter 119, Florida Statutes, and made or received by the District in conjunction with this purchase order. If the Vendor meets the definition of "contractor" as set forth in Section 119.0701, Florida Statutes, the Vendor shall also:

(a) Keep and maintain public records that ordinarily and necessarily would be required by the District in order to perform the service;

(b) Provide the public with access to public records on the same terms and conditions that the District would provide the records and at a cost that does not exceed the cost provided in Chapter 119, Florida Statutes, or as otherwise provided by law;

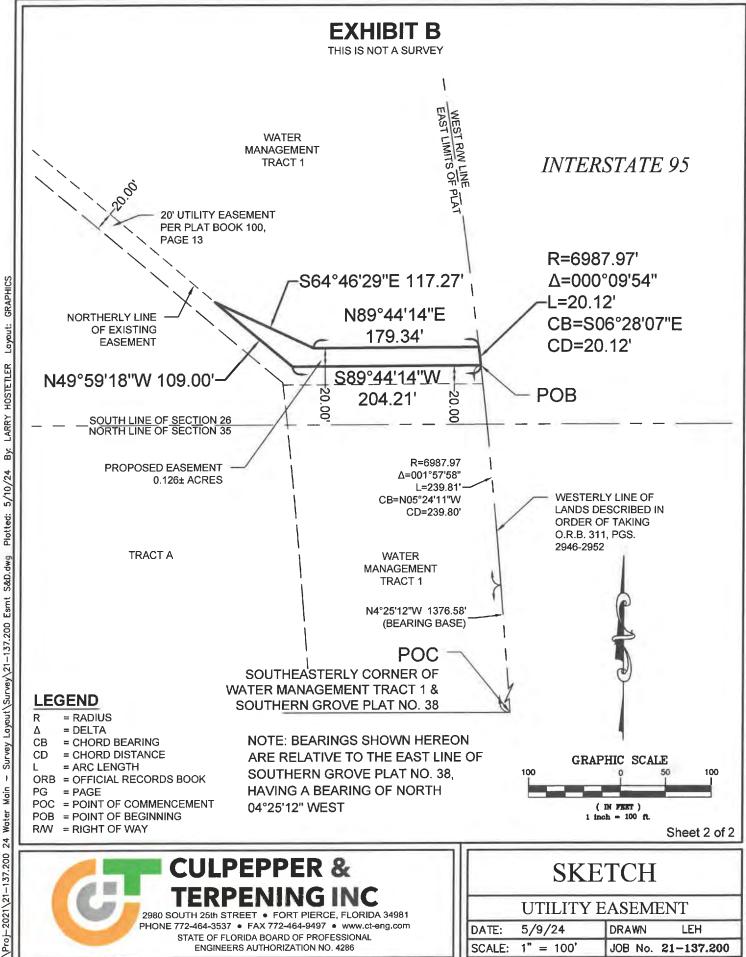

This letter is to provide notification that an inspection and file review of the above referenced project was conducted by South Florida Water Management District (District) staff on June 13, 2024. This inspection and file review indicates that the project is not in compliance with the conditions of the above referenced ERP. Specifically, items that need to be addressed include the following:

1. According to Special Condition 7 of the subject permit, lake side slopes shall be no steeper than 4:1 (horizontal:vertical) to a depth of two feet below the control elevation. Side slopes shall be nurtured or planted from 2 feet below to 1 foot above control elevation to insure vegetative growth and 2:1 (horizontal:vertical) to bottom of slope. The side slope is severly eroded. Please make the necessary repairs.

The District requests correction of noncompliance item(s) noted above within 30 days of the date of this letter.

PETITION FOR FORMAL ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDING

COMES NOW, Petitioner, SOUTHERN GROVE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT NO. 5 ("Southern Grove" or "CDD"), and pursuant to Rule 28-106.201, Florida Administrative Code, and Sections 120.569 and 120.57, Florida Statutes, requests a formal administrative proceeding regarding the above-referenced permit modification and in support thereof states as follows:

Preliminary Statement

- 1. This Petition concerns the May 23, 2024 Modification of Environmental Resource Permit 56-100426-P. The original Environmental Resource Permit, 56-100426-P, will be referred to as the "ERP". The modification of the permit 56-100426-P will be referred to as the "Modification". The ERP authorized construction of a storm water management system ("SWM") serving 67.49 acres of a residential development in St. Lucie County. The residential development is known as Heron Preserve at Tradition ("Heron Preserve").
- 2. The May 23, 2024 Modification transferred the ERP from the original permittee, Pulte Home Company, LLC ("Pulte") to the perpetual operating entities, one of which is Southern

Grove¹. The ERP and the Modification contemplated that Southern Grove would eventually accept the operation and maintenance responsibility for the stormwater lakes, interconnecting pipes, and control structures. The HOA would operate and maintain the remaining aspects of the SWM.

- 3. Southern Grove challenges the Modification because Pulte constructed the stormwater lakes not in compliance with General Condition No. 3 and Special Condition No. 7 of the ERP and installed defective interconnects on stormwater conveyance piping inconsistent with Pulte's design plans that formed the basis for the South Florida Water Management District's ("SFWMD") issuance of the ERP.
- 4. As required by the SFWMD, Pulte's civil engineer, Kinan F. Husainy, P.E., Florida license no.: 75481, signed, sealed, and submitted to the SFWMD an "As-Built Certification" certifying that the stormwater management system was, to the best of his knowledge, "completed in substantial conformance with the plans and specifications and conditions permitted by the [SFWMD]."
- 5. Mr. Husainy's As-Built Certification was submitted to the SFWMD as required for the Modification.
- 6. The Modification would transfer the ERP to the operating entities thereby allowing Pulte to absolve itself of further regulatory obligations for the SWM.
- 7. Until the recent drought conditions in the area, the stormwater lakes were full of water completely covering the lake side slopes and the conveyance piping. In fact, Southern Grove relied on Pulte's engineer's As- Built Certification in its acquiescence to become one of the permittees for the perpetual operation of the stormwater system.
 - 8. In early June 2024, the stormwater lakes began to recede due, in part, to lack of

- rainfall. The recession of the lake elevations exposed eroded lake side slopes and piping defects, both constructed by Pulte as part of the construction phase of the ERP.
- 9. Prior to the lowered lake levels, Southern Grove had no practical way of observing or knowing of the latent defects of the lakes and the stormwater conveyance piping.
- 10. On June 14, 2024, the SFWMD issued a First Notice of Noncompliance to Southern Grove based on the SFWMD's June 13, 2024 inspection of the stormwater lakes and conclusion that the lake side slopes were not in compliance with the ERP (the "Notice"). The Notice requires that Southern Grove correct the non-compliance within thirty (30) days of June 14, 2024.

Timeliness of the Filing of this Petition

- 11. Equitable tolling is a defense to the time limitation in which a party may file a petition challenging agency action. Rule 28-106.111(4), Fla. Admin. Code. Here, Southern Grove raises equitable tolling as a defense to the 21 day time period that appears to have begun on May 24, 2024 and closed on June 13, 2024.
- 12. Generally, equitable tolling has been applied when the plaintiff, or in this case the petitioner, has been misled or lulled into inaction, has in some extraordinary way been prevented from asserting his rights, or has timely asserted his rights mistakenly in the wrong forum. *Machules v. Department of Administration*, 523 So.2d 1132, 1134 (Fla.1988) (citations omitted).
- 13. Pulte's signed and sealed As-Built Certification misled Southern Grove (and the SFWMD) as to the actual defective construction of the lake side slopes and interconnects on the conveyance piping.
- 14. The high water levels in the lakes concealed these defects to Pulte's advantage so that the responsibility for further compliance with SFWMD rules and permit conditions fell to a third party after the Modification.

- 15. When the lake levels receded, side slop conditions were revealed that may not have been otherwise observed anytime in the near future.
- 16. The SFWMD's June 13, 2024 inspection was performed on the same day as the 21 day challenge period closed under Rule 28-106.111. The Notice is dated one day after the challenge period closed. Southern Grove requests that the SFWMD waive the 21 day period under the Rule and accept this Petition as timely based on equitable tolling for the ERP Modification as discussed above.
- 17. This Petition is timely with respect to the SFWMD's June 14, 2024 First Notice of Noncompliance.

Agency Action Being Contested

18. The May 22, 2024 Modification of ERP 56-100426-P and the June 14, 2024 First Notice of Non-Compliance.

Parties

- 19. The Petitioner, Southern Grove #5, is organized and exists under Chapter 190, Florida Statutes. It is one of ten Southern Grove Community Development Districts within the Southern Grove Development of Regional Impact ("DRI").
- 20. The SFWMD is an executive agency of the State of Florida charged with the responsibility of reviewing and taking agency action on certain types of ERPS under part IV of Chapter 373, Florida Statutes.

Petitioner's Substantial Interests

21. Southern Grove's substantial interests in this Petition are founded on its eventual responsibilities and obligations for the perpetual operation and maintenance of certain components of the Heron Preserve stormwater management system as permitted by the ERP, required by the

Modification, and founded also on the required corrective actions imposed by the SFWMD's First Notice of Noncompliance.

Notice of the SFWMD's Decision

22. The Notice of Modification indicates it was issued to an agent for Southern Grove on or about May 23, 2024. The undersigned has not been able to confirm actual service as indicated.

23. Based on the undersigned's information and belief, Southern Grove's District Manager at Special District Services, Inc., received the SFWMD's First Notice of Noncompliance on or about June 17, 2024.

<u>Ultimate Facts Alleged and Specific Facts Warranting Reversal of the SFWMD's Decision,</u> i.e., warranting reversal of the permit modification

- 24. The SWM was not constructed as designed and subsequently permitted.
- 25. Southern Grove should not be held responsible to make the corrections to the stormwater system due to the fact that the Modification, that transfers the ERP from Pulte to the operating entities, was not based on actual conditions, but instead was based on concealed defective conditions.
- 26. To the extent that reasonable assurances for issuance of the ERP and the Modification were based on the SWM design plans and Pulte's licensed engineer's As-Built Certification that the SWM system was constructed as designed, the ERP and the Modification are flawed.

Disputed Issues of Material Fact

- 27. Southern Grove disputes:
- a) whether the Heron Preserve stormwater management system was completed in substantial compliance with the plans, specification, and conditions permitted by the SFWMD;
 - b) whether Pulte provided reasonable assurances that the constructed SWM would not

cause adverse water quality impacts, erosion and/or secondary and cumulative impacts to the surrounding property;

- c) whether the Heron Preserve stormwater management system, as constructed by Pulte, is contrary to the public interest as determined by Rule 62-330.302, Fla. Admin. Code, Section 373.414, Florida Statutes, Applicant's Handbook, Volume I, Parts IV (Erosion & Sediment Control) and V (Operation and Maintenance Specific Requirements), Applicants Handbook Volume II, Parts III (Stormwater Quantity and Flood Control), IV (Stormwater Quality), and V (Water Management System Design & Construction Criteria);
 - d) whether Pulte met the conditions for issuance of the ERP;
- e) whether the ERP should have been modified and transferred to Southern Grove as a perpetual operation and maintenance entity; and
- f) whether Southern Grove should be responsible for correcting Pulte's non-compliant stormwater management system.

Statutes and Rules Requiring Reversal of Permit Modification

- 28. The following Statutes and Rules require reversal of the Modification and treasfer of the ERP to Southern Grove as a perpetual operating entity:
- a) Sections 373.414 and 416 Florida Statutes; Sections 120.569 and 57, Florida Statutes;
 - b) Rules 62-330.350, 401, 301 and 302, Florida Administrative Code;
- c) Applicant's Handbook, Volume I, Parts IV (Erosion & Sediment Control) and V (Operation and Maintenance Specific Requirements);
- d) Applicants Handbook Volume II, Parts III (Stormwater Quantity and Flood Control); IV (Stormwater Quality); and V (Water Management System Design & Construction

Criteria).

Relief Sought by Petitioner

29. Petitioner, Southern Grove #5 requests that this matter be referred to the Florida Division of Administrative Hearings for appointment of an Administrative Law Judge to hear this matter and thereafter:

- a) Reverse the SFWMD's approval of Pulte's construction certification for the ERP;
- b) Reverse of the transfer of the ERP via the Modification as to Southern Grove;
- c) That the SFWMD withdraw its First Notice of Noncompliance directed to the Southern Grove;
- d) Require Pulte to correct any and all deficiencies of its SWM before the SFWMD approves any future transfer of the ERP to the operation and maintenance entities;
 - e) such other relief as deemed appropriate.
