

WHEREAS, the Districts are empowered to provide a funding source and to impose special assessments upon the properties within the Districts; and

WHEREAS, District No. 1 has prepared for consideration and approval an Amended Budget for the Districts.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF SOUTHERN GROVE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT NO. 1 THAT:

Section 1. The Amended Budget for Fiscal Year 2024/2025 attached hereto as Exhibit "A" is hereby approved and adopted.

Subject: Resolution Extending Term

Staff Recommendation

Staff recommends the Board approve the Resolution Extending Terms.

General Information

While initially elected by landowners on a one-acre/one-vote basis, supervisors of a CDD are elected via the general election process administered by the supervisor of elections for the county in which the district is located after it has existed for at least six years and has at least 250 qualified electors residing within its boundaries.

Southern Grove Community Development Districts Nos. 7-10 were each established on November 14, 2025. The initial landowners' elections for each took place a few months after in 2023. The election cycle for all other Southern Grove CDDs fall on even-numbered years. In anticipation of Southern Grove Nos. 7-10 turning over to the general election process in a few years, and the ease of administration in having the St. Lucie County Supervisor of Elections administer all district elections as the same time, these resolutions extend the terms of office for the existing supervisors of Southern Grove Nos. 7-10 by one year in order that they might correspond to the even-year election cycle.

RESOLUTION 2025-27

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF SOUTHERN GROVE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT NO. 7 EXTENDING THE TERMS OF OFFICE OF ALL CURRENT SUPERVISORS TO COINCIDE WITH THE GENERAL ELECTION PURSUANT TO SECTION 190.006, *FLORIDA STATUTES*; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Southern Grove Community Development District No. 7 ("District") is a local unit of special purpose government created and existing pursuant to Chapter 190, *Florida Statutes*; and

WHEREAS, the current members of the Board of Supervisors ("Board") were elected by the landowners within the District based on a one acre/one vote basis; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 190, *Florida Statutes*, authorizes the Board to adopt a resolution extending or reducing the terms of office of Board members to coincide with the general election in November; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that it is in the best interests of the District to adopt this Resolution extending the terms of office of all current Supervisors of the District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF SOUTHERN GROVE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT NO. 7:

SECTION 1. The following terms of office are hereby extended to coincide with the general election to be held in November of 2026:

Seat # 3	(currently held by Peter Crane)
Seat #4	(currently held by Stephen Okiye)
Seat # 5	(currently held by Elijah Wooten)

The following terms of office are hereby extended to coincide with the general election to be held in November of 2028:

- Seat # 1 (currently held by Jennifer Davis)
- Seat #2 (currently held by Kevin Matyjaszek)

SECTION 2. If any provision of this Resolution is held to be illegal or invalid, the other provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall become effective upon its passage and shall remain in effect unless rescinded or repealed.
